**DESCRIPTION OF *LONGIDORUS TRAPEZOIDES* N. SP., AND
MORPHOMETRIC DATA ON *L. ELONGATUS* (DE MAN, 1876)
THORNE & SWANGER, 1936 (DORYLAIMIDA:
LONGIDORIDAE) FROM PAKISTAN**

Abstract

Longidorus trapesoides n. sp., collected from soil around the roots of potato (*Solanum tuberosum*) from Peshwar is described and illustrated. This new species is characterized by narrow trapezoid, slightly offset lip region, long and slender body (L = 5.8-7.2 mm), convex conoid, bluntly rounded tail; asymmetrical amphidial pouch. Morphometric data of some population of *L. elongates* (de Man, 1876) Thorne & swanger, 1936 are also given.
